### **Opening of the EFA Offices in the New Year (2021)**

EFA members and stakeholders following the earlier communication, through Circular No.152, that offices will open for the new year on Wednesday, 6<sup>th</sup> January 2021, and particularly in view of the recently pronounced COVID-19 related restrictions by the Government of the Kingdom of Eswatini, covering the festive period until 6<sup>th</sup> January 2021, hereby wishes to inform her members and stakeholders that the date for the opening of the EFA Offices has been amended and the offices will now open on Thursday, 7<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

This amendment to the reopening of the offices also affects the national Technical Centre, in Lobamba and its associated facilities.

Programmes that had already been scheduled are not going to be affected as they are going to be executed via virtual platforms, where applicable.

EFA is aware that in a few days, the global populace will be celebrating Christmas and New Year days in an unfamiliar configuration in view of the persistent COVID-19 health threat.
