DECLARATION

_____ Football Club with respect to the participation in football clubs' competitions and football activities; locally under the auspices of the EFA and respective league and internationally under the auspices of FIFA, CAF or COSAFA hereby submits a legally valid declaration that;

- a. It recognises as legally binding "the statutes, rules and regulations, decisions and directives" of FIFA, CAF, COSAFA, EFA and PLE;





- b. It recognises the exclusive jurisdiction of the CAS (Court of Arbitration for Sport in Lausanne) for any dispute of international dimension and in particular involving FIFA and /or CAF;
- c. It recognizes the exclusive jurisdiction of the judicial bodies of the EFA and prescribed by the EFA to preside over all cases in football competitions and activities, as stated in the EFA Statutes.
- d. It recognises the prohibition to recourse to ordinary courts under the statutes of FIFA, CAF, EFA and PLE;
- e. Nationally it shall play in competitions that are recognised and endorsed by the EFA (national league, national championship, national cup, etc.);
- f. At continental and global level, it shall play in competitions that are recognised by CAF or FIFA. For the avoidance of doubt, this provision does not relate to friendly matches;
- g. It undertakes to abide by and observe the provisions and conditions of the national club licensing regulations and other associated national regulations in pursuit of the full implementation and conformity to the club licensing system;
- h. All submitted documents are complete and correct ;
- i. It authorises the EFA and/or the Club Licensing Authority to examine documents and seek information and in the event of any appeal procedure- to seek information from any relevant public authority or private body according to national law;
- j. It acknowledges that FIFA and/or CAF reserve the right to execute spot checks at national level reviewing the assessment procedures and the decision-making in case CAF or the EFA fails to implement it;
- k. All our players are registered with the Eswatini Football Association ;



- l. All our Professional Players have written employment contracts with the registered body, according to articles 2 and 5 of the FIFA Regulations for the Status and Transfer of players;
- m. We are fully responsible for the Football team composed of registered players, participating in the National and International Competitions;
- n. The Eswatini Football Association is provided with all the necessary information and/or documents to proving that the licensing obligations are fulfilled, as these obligations relate to the Sporting, Infrastructure, Personnel and Administrative, Legal and Financial Criteria set out respectively under articles 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 of the CAF Club Licensing Regulations;
- o. The rights and duties of our staff are defined in writing;
- p. Any event occurring after the submission of the licensing documentation to the EFA representing a significant change compared to the information previously submitted, will be notified to the EFA by the set deadline.
